The Community Foundation is proud to announce the 2005-2006 Community Trust Grants. Each year the Community Foundation awards grants in the following program areas: Arts & Culture, Basic Needs, Civic Engagement, Education, Environment, Health & Human Services, and Youth. The 2005 Community Trust grant cycle received over 120 proposals. Per the recommendations of community-based committees, the Community Foundation has granted over \$128,000.00 to 63 nonprofit organizations serving Boulder County residents. Programs receiving grants include, but are not limited to the following:

**Arts & Culture:**

- General operating to an agency providing an affordable multidisciplinary home for eighteen of Boulder's finest arts organizations and ad-hoc rental space for many other non-profit organizations.
- An event featuring art exhibitions, a musical showcase, children's art activities, and live theater and dance—all in downtown Longmont one evening for free.

**Basic Needs:**

- A program providing subsidized preventive dental care and/or restorative dental care to a minimum of 350 uninsured low-income children.
- An East Boulder County organization providing assistance by distributing emergency food rations to individuals and families who lack food security.

**Civic Engagement:**

- Services providing low-income immigrants in Boulder County with access to legal assistance for non-criminal matters.
- General operating support for a volunteer clearinghouse supporting volunteer participation and management to Boulder County nonprofit organizations.

**Education:**

- The purchase of literacy and language support materials for English Language Learners for a pre-K through fifth grade program.
- General operating for an organization that diverts quality reusable materials from possible waste and delivers them directly to requesting classrooms at no charge to schools.

**Environment:**

- General operating for a wildlife rehabilitation center focused on returning animals to their natural environment.
- General operating for 15 volunteer projects to restore damaged natural environments on public lands primarily in Boulder County.

**Health & Human Services:**

- Support for medical transportation for low-income seniors and people with disabilities.
- General operating support for prevention education programs to youth and adults that address sexual assault, sexual harassment, gender violence and healthy relationships.

**Youth:**

- Programs providing middle and high-school age youth with opportunities, skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to make informed positive choices related to personal, educational and lifestyle pursuits.
- A program offering after school mentoring and counseling for at risk high school youth in Nederland.
