The Community Foundation is proud to announce the 2006-2007 Community Trust Grants. Each year The Community Foundation awards grants in the following program areas: Arts & Culture, Basic Needs, Civic Engagement, Education, Environment, Health & Human Services, and Youth. The 2006 Community Trust Grant Cycle received over 135 proposals. Per the recommendations of community-based committees, The Community Foundation has granted over \$135,000 to over 80 non-profit organizations serving Boulder County residents. Programs receiving grants include, but are not limited to the following:

### **Arts & Culture:**

- General operating to an agency providing an affordable multi-disciplinary home for 18 of Boulder's finest arts organizations and ad-hoc rental space for many other non-profit organizations.
- The expansion of an art outreach program for youth in Longmont.

### **Basic Needs:**

- General operating to an organization that provides food to 86 partner agencies and distributes over 3.6 million meals this year.
- The only emergency residential living facility for Boulder Youth ages 12 to 18, serving over 100 children per year.

### **Civic Engagement:**

- Effort that coordinates facilitated community conversations throughout Boulder County to build understanding between immigrants and the established community and to foster actions that strengthen the community
- General operating support for a volunteer clearinghouse supporting volunteer participation and management to Boulder County non-profit organizations.

### **Education:**

- Program that provides educational and emotional support through mentoring, tutoring, and social enrichment for low-income, high-risk youth to ensure their success after high school graduation.
- General operating for an organization that provides high quality early learning programs, child care, and family support.

### **Environment:**

- Support for a scholarship fund that enables economically disadvantaged youth to attend residential outdoor/environmental education programs in spectacular outdoor settings.
- General operating for leadership development within a non-profit organization that works on 20 volunteer projects to restore damaged natural environments on public lands primarily in Boulder County.

### **Health & Human Services:**

- Support for a vocational rehabilitation program, serving individuals with severe, persistent mental illness.
- Program providing services for elders to assist them in remaining in their own homes.

### **Youth:**

- Programs providing educational, recreational, and parental activities to at-risk youth and their families to reduce and eliminate risk factors and increase educational expectations and aspirations in the St. Vrain Valley School District.
- A program offering free after-school and summer leadership programming for underserved youth, ages 5-19, in the Lafayette community.
