**Community Foundation grants \$288,212 for additional COVID response,  
civic engagement, and health and human services**

**Boulder County (November 5, 2020)** – Community Foundation Boulder County today announced additional COVID-response grants totaling \$100K, as well as the second round of Community Trust grants: civic engagement grants totaling \$14,701 and grants focused on supporting local health and human services nonprofits totaling \$173,511. All told, the foundation has today awarded \$288,212 in new grants.
